## **RESOLUTION NO. 11065**

WHEREAS, on August 28, 2024, the Commission promulgated Comelec Resolution No. 11045 entitled, "Rules and Regulations Governing: 1) Political Conventions; 2) Submission of Nominees of Groups or Organizations Participating under the Party-List System of Representation and Parliamentary System in the BARMM; and 3) Filing of Certificate of Candidacy and Nomination of and Acceptance by Official Candidate of Registered Political Parties in Connection with the May 12, 2025 National and Local Elections and BARMM Parliamentary Elections";

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Comelec Resolution No. 11045 provides that the Sworn List of Authorized Signatories and Specimen Signatures of Political Parties shall be personally filed by the Chairperson or President, or in their absence, the Secretary-General;

WHEREAS, Section 11 of Comelec Resolution No. 11045 provides that nominees holding appointive or elective office may continue to hold office even after acceptance of their nomination;

WHEREAS, on September 11, 2024, the Commission promulgated Comelec Resolution No. 11051, re-scheduling the filing of Certificate of Candidacy for the position of District Representative in the BARMM Parliament, and the filing of List of Nominees and Certificate of Acceptance of Nomination with Affidavit of Non-Affinity of Regional Parliamentary Political Parties (RPPPs), in light of the Decision in G.R. Nos. 242255, 243246 and 243246 entitled, "Province of Sulu vs. Executive Secretary et al; PHILCONSA vs. Senate et al.; and Dimaporo vs. Comelec", declaring Sulu not part of the Bangsamoro Region;

WHEREAS, there is a need to allow the authorized representative of political parties and coalition of political parties to submit the Sworn List of Authorized Signatories as there might be unforeseen circumstances, acts of God, or force majeure which prevents the Chairperson, President or Secretary-General from filing personally;

WHEREAS, after thorough review, there is a need to amend Section 11 of Comelec Resolution No. 11045, to provide that the nominees of party-list groups, holding appointive offices, including active members of the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and other officers and employees in the government-owned or controlled corporations, who accepts nomination from a party-list group, shall be considered resigned from his/her office, upon the start of the campaign period;

WHEREAS, there is a need to adjust the periods of certain election related activities in connection with the conduct of the BARMM Parliamentary Elections, as a consequence of the re-scheduling of the period for filing of Certificate of Candidacy for the position of District Representative in the BARMM Parliament, and the filing of List of Nominees and Certificate of Acceptance of Nomination with Affidavit of Non-Affinity of RPPP;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Commission on Elections, by virtue of the powers vested in it by the Constitution, the Omnibus Election Code, Republic Acts (RAs) No. 7166, 9369, 7941, 11054 and other election laws, has **RESOLVED**, as it hereby **RESOLVES**, to promulgate the following:

**SECTION 1.** Section 2 of Comelec Resolution No. 11045 is amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. Submission of Sworn List of Authorized Signatories and Specimen Signatures of Political Parties - The Chairperson or President, or in their absence, the Secretary-General or any authorized representative of the PP or coalition of political parties (Coalition) shall personally submit to the Law Department a Sworn List of Authorized Signatories on or before September 30, 2024 (Monday).

Provided that, PP participating in the elections and nominating candidates for District Representative in the BARMM Parliament, may submit their Sworn List of Authorized Signatories and Specimen Signatures, not later than October 30, 2024 (Wednesday).

In case of local PP, the Sworn List of Authorized Signatories shall be personally submitted to the Law Department and furnish a copy to the following offices within the same period:

- Office of the Regional Election Director (ORED), for those registered as Regional PP;
- b. Office of the Provincial Election Supervisor (OPES), for those registered as Provincial PP; and
- c. Office of the City/Municipal Election Officer (OEO), for those registered as City/Municipal PP.

The Chairperson, President or the Secretary-General or any authorized representative of the PP or Coalition must show a sworn Board Resolution, Secretary's Certificate or any other sworn document, as proof of the formal declaration of the PP or Coalition of the authority to submit the Sworn List of Authorized Signatories.

The Sworn List of Authorized Signatories submitted by persons other than the Chairperson, President or Secretary-General or any authorized representative shall be deemed as not filed.

In case of conflict or where there are two (2) or more Sworn Lists of Authorized Signatories submitted by the registered PP, the Sworn List submitted by the Chairperson or President, shall prevail."

**SECTION 2.** Section 11 of Comelec Resolution No. 11045 is amended to read as follows:

**SECTION 11.** *Effects of Acceptance of Nomination.* – Nominees holding appointive or elective office may continue to hold office even after acceptance of their nomination.

Provided that, upon the start of the campaign period, the nominees holding appointive offices, including active members of the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and other officers and employees in the government-owned or controlled corporations, who accepts nomination from a party-list group, shall be considered resigned from his/her office.

The one (1) year prohibition from being hired or rehired in a public office after their party-list organization fail to secure the needed votes to qualify them for a seat in the House of Representatives, shall not apply to them.

A public officer holding a public appointive office or position shall be deemed to include private citizens appointed to public offices representing the private sector.

SECTION 3. Schedule of Related Activities for the Conduct of BARMM Parliamentary Elections. - The following activities and periods in connection with the filing of Certificate of Candidacy (COC) for the position of District Representative in the BARMM Parliament and List of Nominees and Certificate of Acceptance of Nomination with Affidavit of Non-Affinity of Regional Parliamentary Political Parties (RPPPs) for the May 12, 2025 National and Local Elections (NLE) and BARMM Parliamentary Elections (BPE):

**SECTION 4.** *Effectivity.* – This Resolution shall take effect on the seventh day after its publication in two (2) daily newspapers of general circulation in the Philippines.
