FOURTH LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY (Second Regular Session)

[MUSLIM MINDANAO AUTONOMY ACT NO. 149]

Begun and held in Cotabato City, on Monday, the twenty eighth day of October, two thousand two.

AN ACT CREATING BARANGAY KUBENTOG, MUNICIPALITY OF SHARIFF AGUAK, PROVINCE OF MAGUINDANAO, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Regional Legislative Assembly in session assembled:

SECTION 1. The sitios of Kubentog, Mao, Kilala and Tamatalon are hereby created into a separate, distinct and regular barangay from its mother Barangay Limpongo, in the Municipality of Shariff Aguak, Province of Maguindanao, to be known as Barangay Kubentog.

SECTION 2. Barangay Kubentog is bounded by natural and duly designated boundaries with a total area of 1,102.90 hectares, more specifically described as follows:

"Beginning on the point of Origin along points 1 and 2 by Brgy. Pananget bearing 75°53' Southeast with a distance of 2,640 meters; thence, moving Northeast bearing 71°36' for 2,799 meters towards point 3; thence, continuously moving Southeast for 1,700 meters to point 4 along Brgy. Satan; thence, the line moves due to Southwest bearing 71°49' for 6,190 meters to point 5; thence moving Northeast bearing 02°26' for 2,840 meters closing the traverse going to the point of origin point 1."

- SEC. 3. The corporate existence of the barangay created in this Act shall commence upon the appointment or election of the punong barangay and majority of the members of its Sangguniang Barangay.
- SEC. 4. Immediately after the ratification of this Act, the Municipal Mayor of the Municipality of Shariff Aguak shall appoint the punong barangay and seven (7) members of the Sangguniang Barangay.

The chairman and seven (7) members of the Sangguniang Kabataan shall be appointed by the punong barangay.

All appointed Barangay officials shall serve in office until their successors have been elected and qualified in the next regular elections.

- SEC. 5. The creation of the barangay provided in this Act shall take effect when approved by majority of the votes cast in a plebiscite for the purpose.
- SEC. 6. This barangay shall be entitled to an equitable share from the unexpended balance of the IRA share of its mother Barangay until its own annual share from Internal Revenue Allotment is determined and released by the National Government.
- SEC. 7. The Commission on Elections (COMELEC) shall conduct and supervise the plebiscite called for the purpose in the areas directly affected upon request of the Municipal Mayor concerned within ninety (90) days from approval of this Act.
- SEC. 8. The expenses necessary in the conduct of plebiscite shall be appropriated by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Shariff Aguak from any available funds in its Municipal Treasury.
