FIFTH LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY (Third Regular Session)

[MUSLIM MINDANAO AUTONOMY ACT NO. 246]

Begun and held in Cotabato City, on Monday, the nineteenth day of November, two thousand and seven.

AN ACT CREATING BARANGAY MORO POINT IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF PARANG, PROVINCE OF SHARIFF KABUNSUAN, PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Regional Assembly in session assembled:

Section 1. Barangay Moro Point is hereby created out of Barangay Campo Islam, which is in the municipality of Parang.

Sec. 2. The municipal engineer of Parang is hereby authorized to delineate the land area of each barangay by natural and designated boundaries which shall be approved by the municipal mayor concerned.

Sec. 3. The barangay shall be composed of a chairman and such number of kagawads provided in Muslim Mindanao Autonomy Act No. 25 or the ARMM Local Government Code who shall be appointed initially by the mayor of the town.

Unless resigned or incapacitated, the chairman and kagawads shall hold office until their successors shall have been elected and qualified in the next regular barangay election.

Sec. 4. The barangay shall exercise jurisdiction in all matters provided by MMA Act No. 25 and pertinent existing regional and national laws, rules and regulations.

Sec. 5. The Commission of Election (COMELEC) shall conduct and supervise the plebiscite in the affected areas within sixty (60) days or as may be requested by the municipal mayor in the municipality.

Sec. 6. The creation of the barangay shall take effect when approved by the majority of the votes cast in the plebiscite for the purpose.

Sec. 7. The expenses necessary in the plebiscite shall be provided by the government of the municipality of Parang..

Sec. 8. This Act shall take effect upon its publication in a newspaper of regional circulation.
