**LOCAL TESTING CENTERS
FOR THE 2022 BAR EXAMINATIONS**

The simultaneous digital and regionalized modalities of the upcoming Bar Examinations on November 9, 13, 16 and 20, 2022 will be undertaken across the country in the following fourteen (14) local testing centers (LTCs):

The examinees are urged to monitor their Bar PLUS dashboard to view their final LTCs. All venue assignments are final and requests for changes of venue at this point will no longer be entertained.

As well, all examinees are reminded that **October 21, 2022** is the deadline for the following: (1) registering and installing Examplify on the laptop they will use for the 2022 Bar Examinations; and (2) taking of the Sample Examinations 1 and 2. By said date, examinees are advised that they must have already installed Examplify on their laptops and must have uploaded answer files for both Sample Examinations 1 and 2. Those who fail to comply risk the deactivation of their Examplify accounts. These requirements are applicable to new applicants, repeaters, and refreshers.

Once again, examinees are strongly encouraged to download and install Examplify, and take both Sample Examinations on the **same laptop** that they will be using for the 2022 Bar Examinations. These measures are necessary to ensure that the laptops examinees will use to take the Bar Examinations meet the minimum system requirements for Examplify to properly operate. By complying with these requirements, examinees can expect Examplify to run seamlessly, or without major technical issues or concerns.


