ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 49

CREATING A COMMITTEE TO TAKE CHARGE OF THE OBSERVANCE OF PHILIPPINE-AMERICAN DAY ON AUGUST 13, 1954.

Pursuant to the powers vested in me by law, I, RAMON MAGSAYSAY, President of the Philippines, do hereby create a committee to take charge of, and provide the means for, the appropriate observance of Philippine-American Day on August 13, 1954, as declared in Proclamation No. 52 dated July 29, 1954.
