ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 220

CREATING A COMMITTEE TO TAKE CHARGE OF THE OBSERVANCE OF PHILIPPINE AMERICAN DAY ON NOVEMBER 15, 1956.

Purspant to the powers vested in me by law, I, RAMON MAGSAYSAY, President of the Philippines, do hereby create a committee to take charge of, and provide the means for, the appropriate observance of Philippine-American Day on November 15, 1956, as declared in Proclamation No. 363 dated November 3 , 1956.
