ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 453

CREATING A COMMITTEE TO CONDUCT AN INVENTORY OF ALL PLANES AND TO ESTABLISH A POOL TO BE MAINTAINED BY THE PHILIPPINE AIR FORCE OR BY THE PHILIPPINE AIR LINES.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to have available planes at all times for the use of Cabinet Members on a schedule basis:

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish a system of regular maintenance of such planes and to set up standards for the training and checkout of their pilots;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, FERDINAND E. MARCOS, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby create a committee to conduct an inventory of all planes and to establish a pool to be maintained by the Philippine Air Force or Philippine Air Lines. The Committee shall be composed of the following:

A representative of the Bureau of Air Transportation

- Chairman

A representative of the Commission on Audit

- Member

A representative of the Office of

Budget and Management

- Member

The planes made available for the use of any member of the cabinet on a schedule basis.

The Committee shall submit to the President of the Philippines a report of the number of planes and organize a pool to be housed in the Philippine Aerospace Develop

ment Corporation Hangar. The Committee shall also establish a maintenance system, whether at the PAF or PAL, or both in coordination with each other, and organize a technical group to supervise the training and checkout of pilots and the maintenance of the planes.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
