In view of the mutual desire of many of the inhabitants of the townships of Esperanza and Labayug, and upon the recommendation of the Honorable the Secretary of the Interior and the provincial board of Pangasinan Province, and pursuant to the provisions of Act Numbered Seventeen hundred and forty-eight, entitled "An Act authorizing the adjustment of provincial and municipal boundaries and authorizing the change of capitals of provinces and subprovinces, as may be necessary from time to time to serve the public convenience and interest," I hereby consolidate the townships of Esperanza and Labayug, Pangasinan Province, and create in place thereof a township to be known as the township of Artacho: Provided, That the seat of the township government of the township of Artacho shall be at the barrio of Cauringan in the present township of Esperanza.

The fusion herein made shall be effective on January first, nineteen hundred and fourteen.
