In view of the petition of many of the inhabitants of the former municipality of Alcantara, upon recommendation of the provincial board of Cebu, and pursuant to the provisions of Act Numbered Seventeen hundred and forty-eight, entitled "An Act authorizing the adjustment of provincial and municipal boundaries and authorizing the change of capitals of provinces and subprovinces, as may be necessary from time to time to serve the public convenience and interest," the forty-five municipalities of the Province of Cebu as established by Act Numbered Nine hundred and fifty-two and Executive Orders Numbered Seventy-four, series of nineteen hundred and nine, and Nine, Seventy-three and Ninety-six, series of nineteen hundred and twelve, are hereby increased to forty-six by separating from the present municipality of Moalbual, Province of Cebu, the former municipality of Alcantara, said province, and reorganizing the latter into an independent municipality.

The municipality of Moalbual shall consist of its present territory less the territory comprised in the former municipality of Alcantara. The municipality of Alcantara is hereby reorganized and shall consist of the territory which it comprised prior to the passage of Act Numbered Nine hundred and fifty-two: *Provided*, That the salary of the municipal president of Alcantara shall not exceed one hundred and eighty pesos per annum.

The separation herein made shall be effective January first, nineteen hundred and fourteen.
