EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 27.

Upon recommendations of the Secretary of the Interior and the provincial board of Ilocos Sur, and pursuant to the provisions of Act Numbered Seventeen hundred and forty-eight, entitled "An Act authorizing the adjustment of provincial and municipal boundaries and authorizing the change of capitals of provinces and subprovinces, as may be necessary from time to time to serve the public convenience and interest," I hereby separate from the present township of Manabo, Province of Ilocos Sur, that part of the same commonly known as the barrio of Boliney and organize it into a settlement which shall be known as the settlement of Boliney.

The township of Manabo shall consist of the territory heretofore comprised therein less the barrio of Boliney. The settlement of Boliney shall consist of the territory heretofore comprised in the barrio of Boliney, hitherto a part of the township of Manabo.

The separation herein made shall be effective on March seventeenth, nineteen hundred and thirteen.
