EXECUTIVE ORDER) No. 30.

Whereas there is a controversy between the municipalities of Antipolo and Taytay, in the Province of Rizal, as to jurisdiction over the sitios commonly known as Bulao and Mayamut, which is now in litigation between the said municipalities; and

Whereas the Provincial Board of Rizal has once decided that the said sitios of Bulao and Mayamut are within the jurisdiction of the municipality of Antipolo and no good reason appears why such decision of the Provincial Board

should be modified; and

Whereas it has been shown that the said sitios of Bulao and Mayamut properly belong to the municipality of Antipolo and that Antipolo has long been recognized as having jurisdiction: and

Whereas a large majority of the property owners in the said sitios of Bulao and Mayamut are and have been residents of the municipality of Antipolo and have heretofore been paying all taxes into the treasury of said municipality; and

Whereas under Act Numbered Seventeen hundred and forty-eight, the undersigned appears to be vested with power to determine the question administratively, thus avoiding expensive litigation to the said municipalities of Antipolo and Taytay and the residents thereof:

Now, therefore, in view of the petition of many of the inhabitants of Antipolo, Rizal, upon recommendation of Honorable Juan Sumulong, member of the Philippine Commission, and pursuant to the provisions of Act Numbered Seventeen hundred and forty-eight, entitled "An Act authorizing the adjustment of provincial and municipal boundaries and authorizing the change of capitals of provinces and subprovinces, as may be necessary from time to time to serve the public convenience and interest," I hereby transfer the sitios of Bulao and Mayamut from the municipality of Taytay, Province of Rizal, to the municipality of Antipolo, said province.

The municipality of Antipolo shall consist of the territory heretofore comprised therein plus all the territory comprised in the sitios of Bulao and Mayamut, now claimed by the municipality of Taytay, the jurisdiction over which is at present the subject of litigation in the Court of First Instance of Rizal between the said municipalities of Antipolo and Taytay.

The municipality of Taytay shall consist of the territory heretofore comprised therein less the said sitios of Bulao and Mayamut.

The transfer herein made shall be effective on April first, nineteen hundred and thirteen.
