Pursuant to the provisions of section twenty-two of Act Numbered Sixteen hundred and ninety-eight, as amended by Act Numbered Eighteen hundred and eighty-one, I hereby fix the office hours of all officers and employees of the Insular Bureaus and Offices detailed for duty in the city of Baguio from eleven o'clock antemeridian to six o'clock postmeridian, every day exclusive of Saturdays, Sundays, and of days declared public holidays by law or executive order. Employees may be granted one-half hour for luncheon, but arrangements shall be made that the office be not closed or business interrupted. On Saturdays the office hours will be from eight o'clock antemeridian to one o'clock postmeridian, as heretofore fixed in Executive Order Numbered Five, series of nineteen hundred and nine.

This order shall take effect on Friday, May twenty-third, nineteen hundred and thirteen.
