Pursuant to the provisions of Act Numbered Six hundred and forty-eight, Philippine Commission, entitled "An Act authorizing the Governor-General to reserve for civil public purposes, and from sale or settlement, any part of the public domain not appropriated by law for special public purposes, until otherwise directed by law, and extending the provisions of Act Numbered Six hundred and twenty-seven so that public lands desired to be reserved by the Insular Government for public uses, or private lands desired to be purchased by the Insular Government for such uses, may be brought under the operation of the Land Registration Act," I hereby reserve for school purposes and withdraw from sale or settlement a parcel of public domain in the township of Itbayat, Province of Batanes, to wit:

Beginning at a concrete monument marked 1, S. 40° 15' E. 646.25 meters from the tower of the Catholic Church; thence due south 150 meters to a concrete monument marked 2; thence due west 150 meters to a concrete monument marked 3; thence due north 150 meters to a concrete monument marked 4; thence due east 150 meters to monument marked 1, point of beginning.

Containing 22,500 square meters.

Bounded on north, east, south, and west by public land. Bearings magnetic.

Surveyed June 30, 1913.

The description herein given is temporary only and subject to the substitution of a corrected description of said land upon the completion of an official survey of the same.
