The Honorable, the Secretary of Commerce and Police, the mayor of the city of Manila, the Consulting Architect, Mr. John C. Mehan, and Mr. Francisco Perez de Muños are hereby appointed a committee on parks and playgrounds of the city of Manila. It shall be the duty of this committee to study the Burnham plan and to make plans and recommendations for carrying out as nearly as possible the recommendations of Mr. Burnham for the reservation and use of public places in the city of Manila. The committee will meet at the call of the chairman and consider such matters as may be submitted to it by the Executive or brought up at the meeting by any member and is requested to make reports and recommendations from time to time to the Governor-General of any proposed legislation, executive orders, or municipal ordinances which it believes to be desirable to accomplish the purposes for which it is organized.
