Pursuant to the provisions of Act Numbered Six hundred and forty-eight, Philippine Commission, entitled "An Act authorizing the Governor-General to reserve for civil public purposes, and from sale or settlement, any part of the public domain not appropriated by law for special public purposes, until otherwise directed by law, and extending the provisions of Act Numbered Six hundred and twenty-seven so that public lands desired to be reserved by the Insular Government for public uses, or private lands desired to be purchased by the Insular Government for such uses, may be brought under the operation of the Land Registration Act," I hereby reserve for school purposes and withdraw from sale or settlement the following described parcel of public domain in the municipality of Dingle, Province of Iloilo, Island of Panay, to wit:

Beginning at point marked 1 on plan II-8724, S. 60° 51' E. 234.44 m. from B. L. L. M. No. 1, Dingle, thence N. 37° 40' E. 123.34 m. to point 2; S. 58° 01' E. 163.78 m. to point 3; S. 31° 57' W. 95.31 m. to point 4; N. 66° 52' W. 178.2 m. to point 1, point of beginning.

Containing 18,442 square meters.

Points 1 and 2 are P. L. S./B. L. concrete monuments; point 3, bush; point 4, spike in tree.

Bounded on northeast by Sinoy Street; on southeast by property of municipality of Dingle; on southwest by Dakudao Street; on northwest by Devera Street.

Bearings true. Declination, 1° 30' E.
