In view of the petition of the municipal councils of Dinalupihan and Hermosa, Province of Bataan, upon recommendation of the provincial board of said province and pursuant to the provisions of Act Numbered Seventeen hundred and forty-eight, entitled "An Act authorizing the adjustment of provincial and municipal boundaries and authorizing the change of capitals of provinces and subprovinces, as may be necessary from time to time to serve the public convenience and interest," the eleven municipalities of the Province of Bataan, as established by Act Numbered Nine hundred and fifty-seven and Executive Orders Numbered Forty, series of nineteen hundred and seven, and Nine, Nineteen, and One hundred and twenty-four, series of nineteen hundred and eight, are hereby reduced to ten by consolidating the municipalities of Dinalupihan and Hermosa and creating therefrom a new municipality under the name of Bagumbayan.

The municipality of Bagumbayan is hereby organized and shall consist of the territory comprised in the municipalities of Hermosa and Dinalupihan. The seat of municipal government of Bagumbayan shall be in the barrio of Culis.

This order shall take effect on January first, nineteen hundred and fourteen.
