In view of the petition of many of the inhabitants of the barrio of Tabtabagan, municipality of Dingras, Province of Ilocos Norte, upon the recommendation of the provincial board of Ilocos Norte, and pursuant to the provisions of Act Numbered Seventeen hundred and forty-eight, entitled "An Act authorizing the adjustment of provincial and municipal boundaries and authorizing the change of capitals of provinces and subprovinces, as may be necessary from time to time to serve the public convenience and interest," I hereby transfer that part of the present municipality of Dingras, Province of Ilocos Norte, commonly known as the barrio of Tabtabagan, from said municipality of Dingras to the municipality of Banna, said province.

The municipality of Dingras shall consist of the territory heretofore comprised therein less the barrio of Tabtabagan. The municipality of Banna shall consist of its present territory plus the territory heretofore comprised in the barrio of Tabtabagan, hitherto a part of the municipality of Dingras.

The transfer herein made shall be effective January first, nineteen hundred and fourteen.
