EXECUTIVE ORDER)

No. 88.

Paragraph twenty-two of Executive Order Numbered Sixty, series of nineteen hundred and three, reserving a parcel of land in the municipality of Iloilo, Province of Iloilo, for lighthouse purposes, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"22. Reservation for Iloilo port light in the municipality of Iloilo, Province of Iloilo.

"Beginning at point marked 1 on plan In-115, S. 88° 39' E. 1,505.11 m. from B. L. L. M. No. 1, Iloilo, thence N. 37° 18' E. 30.0 m. to point 2; S. 55° 00' E. 150.0 m. to point 3; S. 35° 00' W. 90.0 m. to point 4; N. 48° 55' W. 91.9 m. to point 5; N. 36° 43' E. 18.48 m. to point 6; N. 56° 21' E. 41.29 m. to point 7; N. 56° 21' E. 3.77 m. to point 8; N. 62° 30' W. 64.09 m. to point 9; S. 13° 25' W. 32.2 m. to point 10; N. 68° 29' W. 36.0 m. to point 11; N. 21° 31' E. 1.43 m. to point 12; N. 31° 50' E. 35.7 m. to point 13; S. 52° 42' E.

"Containing 10,002 square meters.

"Points 1, 2, 9 and 13 follow bank and in center of Iloilo River; points 3 to 8, inclusive, on shore and in Iloilo Straits.

"Bounded on northeast by Iloilo River; on southeast by Iloilo Straits; on southwest by Iloilo Straits and Fort San Pedro military reservation; on northwest by property of P. Araneta and J. Yusay and Iloilo River.

"Bearings true. Declination, 1° 30' E.

"Points referred to marked on plan In-115.
