By virtue of the powers in me vested by section eight, paragraph two hundred and fifteen, of an Act of the United States Congress, of August fifth, nineteen hundred and nine, entitled "An Act to raise revenue for the Philippine Islands, and for other purposes," by and with the advice and consent of the Philippine Commission, I hereby continue in force until December thirty-first, nineteen hundred and fourteen, the rates of duty first prescribed in said paragraph on rice imported into the Philippine Islands.
