

## BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE PHILIPPINES

## EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 15 /

AMENDING PARAGRAPH NUMBERED TWENTY-TWO OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBERED ONE, DATED JULY FOUR, NIMETEEN HUN-DRED AND FORTY-SIX, ENTITLED "PRESCRIBING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE GRANTING AND ISSUING OF PASSPORTS."

By virtue of the powers vested in me by law, I, MANUEL ROXAS, President of the Philippines, do hereby amend Paragraph No. 22 of Executive Order No. 1, dated July 4, 1946, so as to read as follows:

"22. A fee of \$\P\$4.00 shall be collected for the execution of each application for passport; \$\P\$50.00 for the issuance of a passport; and \$\P\$25.00 for the renewal thereof."

This Order shall take effect as of August 22, 1946. Done at the City of Manila, this 5<sup>th</sup> day of September, in the year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred and fortysix, and of the Independence of the Philippines, the first.
