EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 20

AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBERED FOUR, DATED JULY ELEVENTH, NUMETEEN HONDRED AND FORTY-SIX, ENTITLED "FIXING THE SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES OF OFFICERS AND ENLISTED MEN OF THE PHILIPPINE ARMY."

By virtue of the powers vested in me by law, I, MANUEL ROWAS, President of the Philippines, do hereby amend Executive Order No. 4, dated July 11, 1946, entitled "Fixing the salaries and allowances of officers and enlisted men of the Philippine Army," so as to include therein the salaries and allowances of officers and enlisted men of the Philippine Army Band, as follows:
