EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 30

EXTENDING THE PERIODS PROVIDED FOR IN SECTIONS 3, 5, AND

6 OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 17, ENTITLED "AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE CIRCULATION OF TREASURY CERTIFICATES

WITH THE OFFICIAL SEAL OF THE REPUBLIC OF THE PHIL-

AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES".

WHEREAS, section 6 of Republic Act No. 17, approved September 25, 1946, provides that treasury certificates not marked as therein provided shall, after November 30, 1946, not be legal tender for the purposes of section

1612 of the Revised Administrative Code;

IPPINES STAMPED, PRINTED OR SUPERIMPOSED THEREON.

WHEREAS, due to lack of time and adequate facilities it is materially impossible to comply with the requirements of sections 3 and 5 of said Act within the time fixed therein;

WHEREAS, it is necessary in the public interest to extend the periods provided for in sections 3, 5, and 6 of said Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MANUEL ROXAS, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by section 7 of Republic Act No. 17, do hereby extend for a period of one month the periods provided for in sections 3, 5, and 6 of Republic Act No. 17.
