BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE PHILIPPIXES EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 37

REORGANIZING THE DEPORTATION BOARD

For the purpose of conducting investigations of undesirable aliens residing in the Philippines in the manner prescribed in Section 69 of the Revised Administrative Code, I, MANUEL ROXAS, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby reorganize the Deportation Board to be composed of -

A Judge of First Instance to be
designated by the Secretary
of Justice ------ Chairman
A ranking officer of the Department of Foreign
Affairs to be designated
by the Secretary of
Foreign Affairs ----- Member
The First Deputy Commissioner
of Immigration ----- Member
The City Fiscal of Manila ---- Member
The Provost Marshal General,
or his representative ---- Member

- 1. The Board shall conduct all investigations in accordance with the following rules and regulations:
 - a. The Deportation Board, motu propio or upon complaint of any person, is authorized to conduct investigations in the manner prescribed in Section 69 of the Revised Administrative Code to determine whether a subject of a foreign power residing in the Philippines is an undesirable alien or not, and thereafter to recommend to the President of the Philippines the deportation of such alien.
 - b. Every person complained against before the Deportation Board shall be informed of the charge or charges against him and shall be allowed not less than three days from notice thereof for the preparation of his defense.
