PROCLAMATIONS

By the Governor General of the Philippine Islands

Proclamation No. 2

Pursuant to the provisions of Act Numbered Eleven hundred and forty-eight, Philippine Commission, entitled "An Act to regulate the use of public forests and forest reserves in the Philippine Islands," I hereby reserve and set apart for public forest purposes and designate as a forest reserve within the meaning of said Act the following-described parcel of public domain in the barrio of Malinao, municipality of Atimonan, Province of Tayabas, Island of Luzon, to wit:

Beginning at point marked 1 on plan, N. 74° 54′ W. 192.21 m. from B. L. B. M. No. 76, thence S. 0° 45′ W. 866.4 m. to point 2; S. 66° 56′ W. 1,233.03 m. to point 3; S. 66° 56′ W. 999.68 m. to point 4; S. 66° 55′ W. 1,000.0 m. to point 5; N. 23° 05′ W. 792.5 m. to point 6; N. 23° 05′ W. 15.0 m. to point 7; N. 23° 04′ W. 792.36 m. to point 8; N. 67° 21′ E. 997.56 m. to point 9; N. 72° 36′ E. 1,113.13 m. to point 10; N. 39° 07′ E. 781.9 m. to point 11; S. 60° 10′ E. 1,303.26 m. to point 12; S. 23° 05′ E. 15.0 m. to point 1, point of beginning.

Containing 5,350,765 square meters.

Points 1 to 8, inclusive, and 12, concrete monuments; points 9, 10, and 11, stone monuments.

Bounded on all sides by public land.

Bearings true. Declination, 0° 47' E.
