MALACAÑAN PALACE MANILA BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE PHILIPPINES PROCLAMATION NO. 59 DECLARING SATURDAY, MARCH 27, 1948, A SPECIAL BANK HOLIDAY WHEREAS, a petition has been received from the Manila Clearing House Association requesting that the twenty-seventh day of March, nineteen hundred and forty-eight, be declared a special bank holiday; WHEREAS, the twenty-fifth day (Holy Thursday) and the twenty-sixth day (Good Friday) of March, nineteen hundred and forty-eight, being public holidays, the twenty-seventh day (Saturday) of March, nineteen hundred and forty-eight, may be declared a special bank holiday to the great advantage of the banks and without any disadvantage to the public in general; NOW, THEREFORE, I, MANUEL ROXAS, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 30 of the Revised Administrative Code, do hereby proclaim Saturday, March twenty-seventh, nineteen hundred and fortyeight, as a special bank holiday. IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be

affixed.

Done in the City of Manila, this 19th day of March, in the year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred and forty-eight, and of the Independence of the Philippines, the second.
