PROCLAMATION NO. 285

REVOKING PROCLAMATION NO. 268 DATED FEBRUARY 29, 1956, WHICH ESTABLISHED THE RESERVATION FOR GRAVEL PROCESSING PLANT SITE PURPOSES OF A PARCEL OF LAND SITUATED IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONTALBAN, PROVINCE OF RIZAL, ISLAND OF LUZON

WHEREAS, under Proclamation No. 268, dated February 29, 1956, there was reserved for gravel processing plant site purposes a certain parcel of land situated in the municipality of Montalban, province of Rizal;

WHEREAS, the said parcel of land is wholly occupied by several tenants whose only source of livelihood is derived from the occupation and cultivation of the same;

WHEREAS, the reservation of the said land is prejudicial to the interest of the municipality of Montalban which will be deprived of much-needed income to undertake its various public service and rural improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, it is advantageous and to the best interest of the State that the title to the said land be first settled and adjudicated by a competent Court;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing premises, upon the recommendation of the Secretary of Agriculture and Natural Resources and by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, I, Ramon Magsaysay, President of the Philippines, do hereby revoke said Proclamation No. 268, dated February 29, 1956.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.

Done in the City of Manila, this 28th day of March, in the year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred and fifty-six, and of the Independence of the Philippines, the tenth.
