Proclamation No. 289

DECLARING MONDAY, APRIL 30, 1956, AS A SPECIAL PUBLIC HOLIDAY

WHEREAS, the 29th day of April 1956 being Sunday and the 1st day of May 1956 being a holiday, the 30th day of April 1956 may be declared a special public holiday without any prejudice to the public interest;

Now, THEREFORE, I, Ramon Magsaysay, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by section 30 of the Revised Administrative Code, do hereby proclaim Monday, April 30, 1956, as a special public holiday.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.

Done in the City of Manila, this 27th day of April, in the year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred and fifty-six, and of the Independence of the Philippines, the tenth.
