PROCLAMATION NO. 356

DECLARING THE FERIOD FROM NOVEMBER 5 TO 11, 1956, AS GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES WEEK.

In order to focus attention on the invaluable services rendered by government employees and thereby encourage them to achieve greater efficiency in the public service, I, RAMON MAGSAYSAY, President of the Philippines, do hereby declare the period from November 5 to 11, 1956, as Government Employees Week. I call upon all citizens and residents of the Philippines as well as all schools and civic organizations to turn their thoughts to the honest, loyal and devoted government employees in grateful appreciation of the services rendered by them. The Week should likewise be devoted to the attainment of maximum service efficiency and the highest degree of harmony and cooperation between the public and the employees.
