PROCLAMATION NO. 358

DECLARING SATURDAY, OCTOBER 20, 1956, AS A SPECIAL PUBLIC HOLIDAY IN THE PROVINCE OF LEYTE AND IN THE CITIES OF TACLOBAN AND ORMOG.

WHEREAS, the twelfth anniversary of the landing on the shores of Leyte of the United States Armed Forces in their mission to liberate the country from enemy occupation falls on October 20, 1956; and

WHEREAS, the people of Leyte, to whom such historic event is of special significance, desire to celebrate its anniversary with appropriate ceremonies;

NOW, THE REPORE, I, RAMON MAGSAYSAY, President of the Philippines, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Section 30 of the Revised Administrative Code, do hereby declare Saturday, October 20, 1956, as a special public holiday in the province of Leyte and in the cities of Tacloban and Ormoc.

IN WITHISS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.

Done in the City of Manila, this 13% day of October, in the year of Cur Lord, nineteen hundred and fifty-six, and of the Independence of the Philippines, the eleventh.
