PROCLAMATION No. 378

DECLARING FRIDAY, APRIL 2, 1965, AS A SPECIAL
PUBLIC HOLIDAY IN THE PROVINCES OF BULA-
CAN AND BATAAN.

WHEREAS, the second day of April is the birthday of
Francisco Balagtas, Prince of Filipino Poets; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that the people of Bu-
lacan, his birthplace, and Bataan, where he lived and died,
should be given full opportunity to celebrate his birthday;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Diosdado Macapagal, President of
the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by
Section 30 of the Revised Administrative Code, do hereby
declare Friday, April 2, 1965, as a special public holiday
in the provinces of Bulacan and Bataan.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and
caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines, to be
affixed.

Done in the City of Manila, this 16th day of March, in
the year of Our Lord nineteen hundred and sixty-five.
