PROCLAMATION No. 412

DECLARING THE PERIOD FROM DECEMBER 6 TO 12,
1965, AS SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY WEEK
AND CREATING A COMMITTEE TO TAKE
CHARGE OF ITS OBSERVANCE.

In order to give impetus to the role of science in the development of the country, I, Diosdado Macapagal, President of the Philippines, do hereby declare the period from December 6 to 12, 1965, as Science and Technology Week to be observed throughout the country in schools, colleges and universities, with appropriate ceremonies, under the sponsorship of the National Science Development Board.
