PROCLAMATION NO. 240

RESERVING FOR TRADE SCHOOL SITE FURPOSES A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND OF THE PUBLIC DOMAIN SITUATED IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SALVADOR, PROVINCE OF LANAGUEE NORTE, ISLAND OF MINDANAO.

Upon recommendation of the Secretary of Environment and Natural Resources and pursuant to the authority vested in me by law, I, CORAZON C. AGUINO, President of the Philippines, do hereby withdraw from sale or settlement and reserve for trade school site purposes under the administration of the Director of Vocational Education, subject to private rights, if any there be, a certain parcel of land of the public domain situated in the municipality of Calvador, Province of Lanso del Norte, Island of Mindanao, which is more particularly described as follows:

(PROPUSED SALVADOR TRADE SCHOOL SITE RESERVATION)

A parcel of land, Lot No. 2885-A, Pls-13, Case No. 2, situated in the Foblacion of Salvador, Lanao del Norte, bounded on the Northwest along line 1-2 by Lot No. 2885-B, Pls-13, C-2; on the Northeast along line 2-3-4 by road; on the Southeast along line 4-5 by road and on the Southeast along line 5-1 by Lot No. 1044, Pls-13, Case No. 2. Containing an area of EIGHTY THOUSAND S UARE METERS (80,000). Beginning at a point marked "1" of Lot No. 2885-A, 41s-13. Case No. 2, being:
