PROCLAMATION NO. 90

DECLARING THE SECOND WEEK OF NOVEMBER OF EVERY YEAR AS
"NATIONAL SCOUT CLEAN-UP WEEK"


WHEREAS, these values are relevant to our ardent quest for a progressive, peaceful and clean society, and therefore, must be strengthened;
