PROCLAMATION NO. 286

DECLARING TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 1993, AS A SPECIAL DAY  
THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY

WHEREAS, All Saints' Day, which is a Nationwide Special Day, falls on a Monday, November 1, 1993;

WHEREAS, Tuesday, November 2, 1993, may be declared as a special day without prejudice to the public service to enable the people to go to the provinces to pay their respects to their departed relatives;


