PROCLAMATION NO. 413

FOR ESTABLISHING AS CATBALOGAN WATERSHED FOREST RESERVE PURPOSES OF PROTECTING, MAINTAINING, AND IMPROVING ITS WATER YIELD AND PROVIDING RESTRAINING MECHANISM INAPPROPRIATE FOREST EXPLOITATION AND DISRUPTIVE LAND USE, A PARCEL OF LAND OF THE PUBLIC DOMAIN SITUATED THE MUNICIPALITIES OF CATBALOGAN AND JIABONG, OF WESTERN SAMAR, PHILIPPINES

Upon recommendation of the Secretary of Environment and Natural Resources and by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, I, FIDEL V. RAMOS, President of the Philippines, hereby withdraw from entry, sale, disposition, or settlement, and set aside as Catbalogan Watershed Forest Reserve, subject to private rights, if there be any, and to the operations of previous proclamations reserving any portion thereof for specific purposes and to the implementation of socially-oriented projects and other forestry development programs consistent with the objective of the proclamation as may be determined by the Secretary of Environment and Natural Resources, a certain parcel of land of the public domain located in the Municipalities of Catbalogan and Jiabong, Province of Western Samar, Philippines, particularly described as follows:

Beginning at point "1" on the map is a point on the ground of Catbalogan Cadastre, Catbalogan, Western Samar and is identical to Barangay Boundary Monument (BBM) No. 13 latitude 11°48'31.6" and longitude 124°53'29.8";

Thence N 86 37'W, 305.5 meters to ... corner 48, represented by BL Concrete monument identical; to corner 4 of Lot-719, Cad. 255;

Thence S 50 49'W, 32.5 meters to corner 49, a stake identical to corner No. 76° , Timberland Project No. 9-c;

Thence S 68 00'W, 90.0 meters to corner 50, represented by BL Concrete monument identical to corner 3 of Lot-719, Cad. 255;

Thence S 68 00'W, 110.0 meters to corner 51, represented by BL Concrete monument identical to corner 7 of Lot-720, Cad. 255;

Thence N 14 00'W, 280.0 meters to corner 52, represented by BL Concrete monument identical to corner 6 of Lot-720, Cad. 255;

Thence N 10 00'W, 120.0 meters to corner 53, represented by BL Concrete monument identical to corner 5 of Lot-720, Cad. 255;

Thence N 50 00'W, 40.0 meters to corner 1, the point of beginning, containing an area of Eight Hundred Four point nine (804.9) hectares, more or less.

The area govered by the reservation shall be under the administrative jurisdiction, supervision, and control of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources, through its Forest Management Bureau, in coordination with other agencies of the government with the objective of maintaining its usefulness as a source of potable water, for irrigation, domestic use, and other forestry purposes.
