PROCLAMATION NO. 485

DECLARING MONDAY, OCTOBER 31, 1994, AS A SPECIAL DAY
THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY

WHEREAS, paying homage to the dead on All Saints' Day, celebrated on the first day of November of every year, is one of our most cherished traditions;

WHEREAS, to give all full opportunity to our people to properly observe the day with all its religious fervor, which invariably requires them to travel to different regions of the country, Monday, October 31, 1994, which falls between a Sunday and All Saints' Day, November 1, 1994, may be declared as a special day without detriment to public interest.

NOW THEREFORE, I, FIDEL V. RAMOS, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby declare Monday, October 31, 1994, as a special day throughout the country.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.
