PROCLAMATION NO. 676

DECLARING A STATE OF CALAMITY IN FOUR (4) PROVINCES AND ONE
(1) CITY ADVERSELY AFFECTED BY TROPICAL STORM "MAMENG"

Upon recommendation of the Secretary of National Defense and Chairman of the National Disaster Coordinating Council (NDCC) and pursuant to the powers vested in me by law, **I, FIDEL V. RAMOS**, President of the Philippines, do hereby declare the existence of a State of Calamity in the following areas adversely affected by tropical storm "Mameng":
