PROCLAMATION NO 910

DECLARING SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 1996 AS A SPECIAL DAY
THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY

WHEREAS, paying homage to the dead on All Saints' Day, celebrated on the first day of November each year, is one of our most cherished traditions

WHEREAS, to give full opportunity to our people to properly observe the day with all its religious fervor which invariably requires them to travel to different regions of the country, Saturday, November 2, 1996 which falls between All Saints' Day and a Sunday may be declared as a special day without detriment to public interest.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, FIDEL V. RAMOS, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby declare Saturday, November 2, 1996 as a special day throughout the country.
