PROCLAMATION NO. 1101

DECLARING A STATE OF CALAMITY IN TANGUB CITY

Upon recommendation of the Secretary of National Defense as Chairman of the National Disaster Coordinating Council (NDCC), and by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, I, **FIDEL V. RAMOS**, President of the Philippines, do hereby declare a state of calamity in Tangub City which was affected by flashflood due to continuous heavy rains in December 1996.


All departments and other government agencies concerned are hereby directed to implement and execute relief and rehabilitation work in accordance with existing operational plans and directives and orders issued in connection with calamities.
