PROCLAMATION NO. 1233

DELINEATING THE TERRITORIAL BOUNDARIES OF THE LARENA PORT ZONE

Upon the recommendation of the Regional Development Council of Region VII (Central Visayas) and the Philippine Ports Authority and pursuant to the powers vested in me by law, I, FIDEL V. RAMOS, President of the Philippines, do hereby delineate the territorial boundaries of the Port of Larena in the Province of Siquijor consisting of a total area of 131,812.82 square meters, more or less, as defined by the herein technical description:

"Beginning at point marked 1 on the plan, thence to point 2 at a distance of 88.00 m with bearing N76° 30' W, thence to point 3 at a distance of 150.00 m with bearing N52° 30' W, thence to point 4 at a distance of 200.00 m with bearing N66° 00' W, thence to point 5 at a distance of 260.00 m with bearing N24° 00' E, thence to point 6 at a distance of 488.05 m with bearing S66° 00' E, thence to point 7 at a distance of 249.92 m with bearing S24°00' W, thence to point 8 at a distance of 10.00 m with bearing S39° 00' W, thence to point 9 at a distance of 27.50 m with bearing N51° 00' W, thence to point 1, the point of beginning at a distance of 37.50 m with bearing S69° 00' W."

Pursuant to Presidential Decree No. 857 (Revised PPA Charter issued on 23 December 1975), as amended, the Philippine.Ports Authority, which exercises administrative jurisdiction over the Larena Port Zone, shall implement a program for the proper zoning, planning, development and utilization of the port, consistent with the regional development plans of the Government.



The technical description and area covered by this proclamation are subject to change upon approval of the actual survey.
