## PROCLAMATION NO. 161

## DECLARING FRIDAY, AUGUST 20, 1999 AS A SPECIAL DAY IN THE CITY OF DAVAO

**WHEREAS**, it is fitting and proper that the people of the City of Davao be given full opportunity to celebrate this event with appropriate ceremonies;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** I, **JOSEPH EJERCITO ESTRADA**, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by Book I, Chapter 7, Section 27 of the Administrative Code of 1987, do hereby declare Friday, August 20, 1999 as a special day in the City of Davao.
