PROCLAMATION NO. 44

DECLARING MONDAY, MAY 14, 2001, AS A SPECIAL PUBLIC (NON-WORKING) HOLIDAY THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY

WHEREAS, the national and local elections shall be beld on Monday, May 14, 2001;

WHEREAS, Monday, May 14, 2001, should be declated a special public (non-working) holiday to give the people the fullest opportunity to page in the said elections:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, GLORIA MACAPAGAL ARROYO, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby declare Monday, May 14, 2001, as a special public (non-working) holiday throughout the country
