PROCLAMATION NO. _79

DECLARING MONDAY, AUGUST 13, 2001 AND TUESDAY, AUGUST 14, 2001, AS SPECIAL NON-WORKING HOLIDAYS IN THE AUTONOMOUS REGION IN MUSLIM MINDANAO (ARMM)
