PROCLAMATION NO. 604

AMENDING PROCLAMATION NO. 20, S. 1926 WHICH RESERVED CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND SITUATED IN THE CITY OF DAVAO FOR WIRELESS STATION PURPOSES BY EXCLUDING FROM ITS OPERATION THE UNUTILIZED PORTIONS OF THE LAND EMBRACED THEREIN AND DECLARING THE SAME OPEN FOR DISPOSITION IN FAVOR OF THE ACTUAL OCCUPANTS UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE PUBLIC LAND ACT, AS AMENDED

Upon the recommendation of the Secretary of Environment and Natural Resources, and by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, **I, GLORIA MACAPAGAL ARROYO**, President of the Republic of the Philippines, do hereby amend Proclamation No. 20 dated March 23, 1926 which reserved certain parcel of land situated the City of Davao, Island of Mindanao for wireless station purposes, by excluding from its operation the unutilized portions of the land embraced therein and declaring the same open for disposition under the provisions of the Public Land Act, as amended, subject to private rights, if there be any, which portions of land are more particularly described as follows;

An Inter-Agency Committee (LIAC), composed of representatives from HUDCC as Chair, the City Government of Davao, DENR, PCUP and the people's organization in the area as members is hereby created to immediately prepare the implementing rules and regulations (IRR) of this proclamation.

Except in favor of the government or any of its branches or agencies, all lands disposed under this Proclamation shall not be subject to alienation and encumbrance for a term of ten years from the issuance of the title in case of sale or execution of contract in case of lease, nor shall they become liable to the satisfaction of any debt contracted prior to the expiration of said period, but the improvements on the land maybe mortgaged to qualified persons, associations or corporations.
