**PROCLAMATION NO. 924**

**DECLARING SATURDAY, OCTOBER 8, 2005, AS SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAY IN THE CITY OF KORONADAL, PROVINCE OF SOUTH COTABATO**

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 8803 dated August 16, 2000, provided for the conversion of the Municipality of Koronadal into a component city to be known as the City of Koronadal and was ratified on October 8, 2000;

**WHEREAS**, Saturday, October 8, 2005, marks the 5<sup>th</sup> Charter Day anniversary of the City of Koronadal;


