PROCLAMATION NO. 933

**DECLARING FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 4, 2005 AS A REGULAR HOLIDAY
THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY IN OBSERVANCE OF EID'L FITR
(FEAST OF RAMADHAN)**

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9177 declared *Eid'l Fitr* (Feast of Ramadhan) as a regular holiday;

WHEREAS, the month of Ramadhan may culminate on November 2 or 3, 2005 subject to the sighting of the moon on November 1, 2005;

WHEREAS *Eid'l Fitr* is celebrated by the Muslim World for three (3) days after the end of the month of fasting;

WHEREAS, the main date for the celebration of *Eid'l Fitr* for the year 2005 has been determined to fall on Friday, November 4, 2005;

WHEREAS, to promote cultural understanding and integration, the entire Filipino Nation should have the full opportunity to join their Muslim brothers and sisters in the observance and celebration of *Eid'l Fitr*;

WHEREAS, in order to bring the religious and cultural significance of the *Eid'l Fitr* to the fore of national consciousness, it is necessary to declare Friday, November 4, 2005 as a regular holiday throughout the country;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDUARDO R. ERMITA, by authority of Her Excellency **GLORIA MACAPAGAL ARROYO**, President of the Philippines, do hereby declare Friday, November 4, 2005 as a regular holiday throughout the country.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.


