PROCLAMATION NO. 1042

**DECLARING FRIDAY, APRIL 21, 2006, AS SPECIAL (NON-WORKING)

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.


