WHEREAS, Tuesday, 2 August 2011, marks the 61st Charter Day anniversary of the City of Butuan;


WHEREAS, it is but fitting and proper that the people of the City of Butuan be given full opportunity to celebrate and participate in the occasion with appropriate ceremonies.
