DECLARING FRIDAY, 2 SEPTEMBER 2011, AS A SPECIAL (NON-
WORKING) DAY IN THE PROVINCE OF IFUGAO

WHEREAS, Friday, 2 September 2011 marks the 66th anniversary of the end of World War II in the Philippines, a moment of glory in our national history;


