DECLARING MONDAY AND FRIDAY, OCTOBER 13 AND 24, 2014, RESPECTIVELY, AS SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAYS IN THE CITY OF ANGELES

WHEREAS, the City of Angeles marks the celebration of the month-long Kuliat Festival (Fiestang Kuliat) and the Tigtigan Terakan Keng Dalan, street singing and dancing festival to commemorate the city's resiliency and dynamism after the Mt. Pinatubo eruption in 1991;
